

# Wellow Sports Funding 2014



The government has provided £150 million per annum for the academic years 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 for primary school sports funding.

The funding is being jointly provided by Departments for Education; Health; and Culture, Media and Sport.

Money is going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of Sport and PE for all children in school. Our grant is delegated as follows:

In order to build on the excellent provision already in place at Wellow, our funding for this academic year will be spent as follows...

- £2,000 - participation in local and regional sports competition via Personal Best Education (PBed)
- £400—additional specialist coaching for dance lessons
- £6400 - towards specialist multi use games area to be constructed during 2014

We have chosen to invest in improved outdoor facilities that will enhance lessons and learning, as well as providing better facilities for active play at break and lunchtimes.

The construction of a purpose built Multi use games area, MUGA, will also provide enhanced facilities for the many after school clubs we currently offer.
